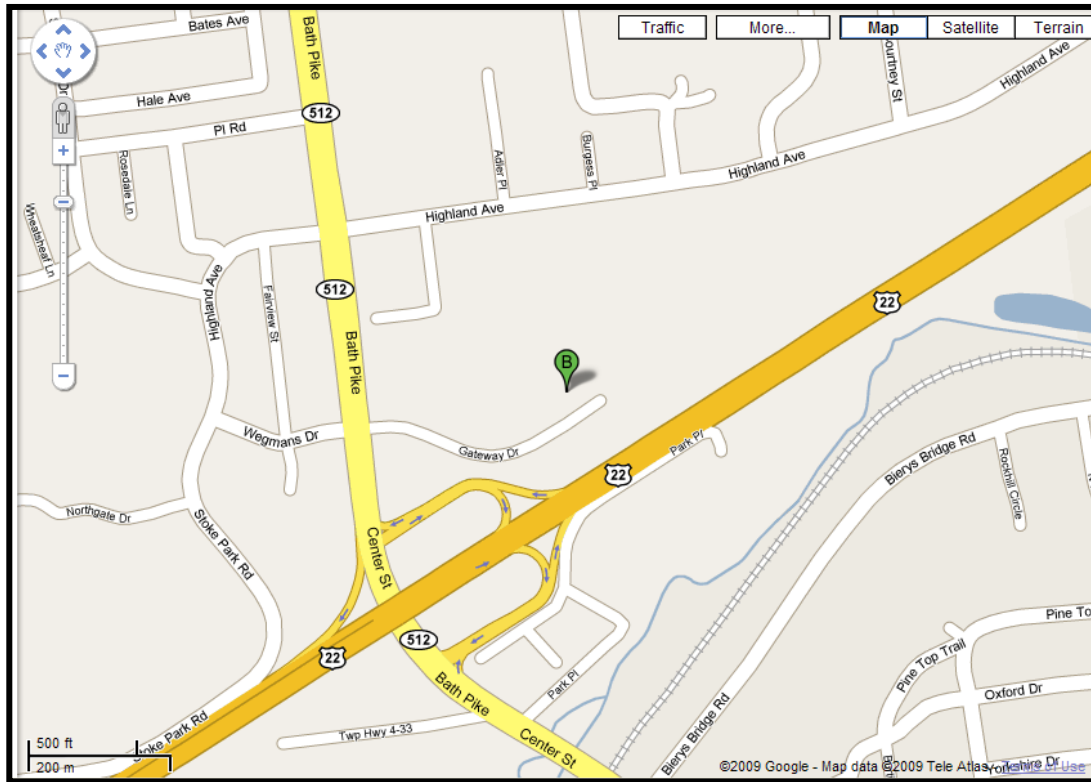

Course Description:
Background Information
This 2-day course has been developed to fulfill the training requirements for State Conservation Commission grant recipients under Act 3 of 1997.

Course Content
This multi-media course runs 2 days and the updated course content features:
• Introduction
• Environmentally Sensitive Maintenance Practices, Successful Projects and "Real" Life Examples
• Regulations & Grant Procedures

Who Should Attend:
The municipal person who has prime responsibility to maintain the road system plus any municipal official/employee who may be involved in road maintenance operations or road maintenance administration or management.

At least one municipal official or employee must attend the training course and receive the attendance certificate in order for a municipality to apply for and receive grant funds.

Approval of the following two policies.

1. Environmentally Sensitive Maintenance Training for Municipalities and Other Grant Recipients

Effective January 1, 2006 at least one person representing the entity that has applied for funds from the Dirt and Gravel Road Maintenance Program must have attended environmentally sensitive maintenance training for dirt and gravel roads within the past five (5) calendar years.

2. Environmentally Sensitive Maintenance Training for Conservation Districts

Effective January 1, 2006 the person or persons responsible for administering the Dirt and Gravel Road Maintenance Program in the county conservation districts and at least one of the two members of the Quality Assurance Board who represent the conservation district must have attended environmentally sensitive maintenance training for dirt and gravel roads within the past five (5) calendar years.
